Closing will occur on June 29 2018.

"As a step towards focusing and further concentrate our property portfolio to Helsingborg and Höganäs, the divestment of the Åstorp properties is well inline with this strategy, says Cassandra Jertshagen, CEO Jefast."

The five properties are located in Åstorp with a total lettable area of approximately 28,500 m2 with an annual rental value of 26.5 MSEK. The cash flow of the group will be affected accordingly. The preliminary purchase price for the shares in the property-owning company amounts to 128.8 MSEK, and the payment for the shares will take place on June 29 2018.
